

RESOLUTION NUMBER 61

Rescinding Resolution Number 60

WHEREAS, GURA and the City of Golden adopted an Intergovernmental Agreement on June 28, 1990 and subsequent documents amended to it including a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) dated May 7, 2004 that established a “lend-lease” employee relationship between GURA and the City; and

WHEREAS, the benefits accruing to Debbie Rainguet as a part-time GURA/City employee under GURA Resolution 60 requesting that she be employed by the City under the MOU would be inferior in some respects to the benefits accruing to her under her current employment agreement with GURA, and

WHEREAS, Debbie Rainguet prefers to remain employed by GURA under her current terms;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOLDEN URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY THAT:

The Board of Commissioners of the Golden Urban Renewal Authority hereby rescinds Resolution 60 and retracts its request that the City Manager add Debbie Rainguet as a City employee under the MOU.
