

## Golden Vision 2030 Plan

The City of Golden has a unique identity that its community cares for deeply. The values that make up Golden's small town character are characterized by the City's numerous boards, commissions, task forces, and community organizations. Preserving those elements within the community that contribute to Golden's identity is important to current and future planning efforts.

A well-articulated and shared vision of Golden's future is necessary and critical to maintaining community values. The Golden Vision 2030 Plan process will attempt to capture those community values and produce a long-term strategic plan for community investments and policy actions to achieve the vision. If the City's strategic plans can incorporate the community's core values, Golden will reflect what the community desires. Ultimately, our core planning documents such as the Comprehensive Plan, Capital Improvement Plan, or Downtown Plan could be amended to align with the community's core values.


To begin the process of the Golden Vision 2030 Plan, City Council has created a Local Advisory Committee (LAC) to guide the process. The LAC will meet on a monthly basis for a period of two years until the Plan is completed. The role of the Golden Vision 2030 Plan Local Advisory Committee shall be to ensure inclusiveness and representation for all groups within the City of Golden on the process regarding public input and engagement for the Plan. Thirteen members of the LAC will represent various boards and commissions and three at-large members of the public will be appointed to the committee.

The LAC will have their first meeting on Tuesday, February 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6 pm in the Council Chambers room at City Hall. A larger kickoff event for the Golden Vision 2030 Plan will be held on Tuesday, February 10<sup>th</sup> at 6 pm. This event, "Warming Up to Golden's Heart & Soul" will be open to the public, include refreshments, and provide information on the Golden Vision 2030 Plan process.

Boards and Commissions are asked to appoint one member to attend meetings on a monthly basis to represent their constituency. Times and a location for future meetings are not as of yet planned, but will likely be early evening during a workday at either City Hall or the Community Center.
