



Mission: Zero Waste

The Original Woody's Wood-Fired Pizza and Watering Hole has committed to sustainability in an effort to enrich our community, the natural environment, and the long-term profitability of our family-owned business. With help from GURA, Woody's has taken large strides towards reaching water conservation and renewable energy generation goals. Today we hope that GURA will once again help Woody's set an example for downtown businesses who wish to lessen their impact on the environment, while showing neighboring communities that Golden is on the leading edge of community sustainability.

In previous attempts to decrease the waste being sent to landfills, Woody's has been recycling comingled containers and cardboard. In the last year we have diverted roughly half of our waste stream, amounting to over 50,000 cubic feet of materials being recycled. Next, Woody's will partner with A-1 Organics to implement a food-waste recycling program. A-1 Organics will compost all of our food waste including produce, meat, bones, compostable straws, etc. The new diversion rate will be somewhere around 95%; one step closer to **Zero Waste**.

As you know, breaking from traditional methods costs money. Implementing this program will cost \$50 each week for the service, plus the cost of compostable bags, collection containers, and compostable EcoProducts. That is why I have written you today. I am hoping that GURA will once again partner with Woody's and help us reach our collective sustainability goals together. Please review the attached budget for this program.
