**Golden Downtown Pedestrian Plan Goals**

**Pedestrian Goals for the Downtown Core:**

1. Walking downtown is safe and relatively unimpeded.
2. Downtown is family friendly to walkers, especially those with children.
3. No car goes over (25) miles per hour on Washington, Ford, and Jackson Avenues.
4. Coors visitors feel comfortable and safe walking from the Coors parking lot to the downtown.
5. All seniors living downtown need to feel safe when walking outside their homes, both day and night and especially those using canes and walkers need to feel on the sidewalks and using cross walks.
6. Pedestrians have the right of way on downtown cross-walks and this policy should be enforced.
7. Downtown is safe for pedestrians and not a hassle for drivers driving through the downtown.
8. Active cell phone use when driving in the downtown should be prohibited.
9. Vehicles need to be slowed down coming from Colorado 58 to 10<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Measurement Goals:**

1. Safety is measured by accidents and injuries as well as near-misses and fear of being hit when walking in the downtown.
