**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF
THE “FasTracks” BALLOT PETITION**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Colorado Urban Renewal Law, Sections 31-25-101, et seq., C.R.S. (the Law), the Golden Urban Renewal Authority (GURA) is carrying out the Golden Urban Renewal Plan - a.k.a. Golden downtown Redevelopment Plan (the Plan), which was approved by the City Council of the City of Golden on December 28, 1989; and

WHEREAS, the general assembly has found and declared that urban renewal areas constitute an economic and social liability and that the prevention and elimination of blight in urban renewal areas is a valid public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the development of multi-modal public transit options such as what is proposed by the “FasTracks” proposition would alleviate certain causes of blight and assist in the prevention of blight in the GURA District:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOLDEN URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY THAT the Golden Urban Renewal Authority supports and endorses the FasTracks ballot initiative.
